Similarly, employers consider English proficiency a vital competency for professional advancement, particularly in multinational corporations and technology-driven industries.

The main objective of this study is to investigate the significance of English language proficiency in educational attainment and professional growth. RESULTS

Academic performance

Independent learning and online course participation were significantly higher among high proficiency students.

Professional development

High proficiency participants reported greater participation in international internships (65%) and professional programs (58%).



Mastery of professional English terminology was observed in 75% of high proficiency participants.

Low proficiency participants had limited access to international professional networks and publications.

Communication skills

High proficiency participants excelled in presentations, teamwork, and leadership roles.

Intermediate learners demonstrated moderate skills, requiring additional practice.

Low proficiency learners often struggled with professional correspondence and oral communication in English.

The findings demonstrate that English proficiency is strongly correlated with both academic and professional success. English enables access to global knowledge, improves collaboration skills, and increases employability in multinational environments. In particular:

Academic mobility and participation in international programs are enhanced.

Professional competencies, including technical and soft skills, are improved.

Confidence in global communication and digital literacy is higher.

Challenges include motivational barriers, insufficient practical exposure to English in the curriculum, and lack of emphasis on English for specific purposes (ESP). Addressing these challenges requires integrating communicative and content-based approaches in English language instruction.
