



E'LON TILIDAGI XATOLAR: LINGVISTIK VA AMALIY TAHLIL

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ABSTRACT

This article analyzes common mistakes in announcement (advertising and public notice) language from a linguistic and practical perspective. It focuses on grammatical, lexical, stylistic, and orthographic errors frequently found in public announcements written in Uzbek and other languages. The study also explains the reasons for such mistakes, including lack of language proficiency, influence of informal speech, and translation issues. Furthermore, the article suggests ways to improve announcement writing in order to make communication clearer, more professional, and more effective.

Mazkur maqolada e'lon (public notice) tilida uchraydigan xatolar lingvistik va amaliy jihatdan tahlil qilinadi. Grammatik, leksik, imlo va uslubiy xatolar misollar orqali yoritiladi. Shuningdek, bunday xatolarning kelib chiqish sabablari va ularni bartaraf etish yo'llari ko'rib chiqiladi. Maqola e'lon matnlarini to'g'ri va tushunarli yozish madaniyatini rivojlantirishga qaratilgan.

KIRISH

E'lonlar bizning kundalik hayotimizda juda ko'p uchraydigan yozma axborot shaklidir. Maktabda, universitetda, internet sahifalarida yoki ko'chadagi taxtachalarda biz har kuni turli e'lonlarni ko'ramiz. Ularning asosiy vazifasi — odamga kerakli ma'lumotni tez, qisqa va aniq yetkazish.

Lekin amaliyotda shuni ko'rish mumkinki, e'lonlar har doim ham to'g'ri yozilmaydi. Ba'zan imlo xatolari, ba'zan grammatik yoki uslubiy kamchiliklar uchraydi. Natijada oddiy bir e'lon ham tushunarsiz yoki ishonchsiz bo'lib qolishi mumkin. Aslida esa e'lon matni eng sodda, eng aniq va eng toza yozilishi kerak bo'lgan matn turlaridan biridir.

INTRODUCTION

Announcements are one of the most common forms of written communication in daily life. We encounter them at school, university, online platforms, and public places almost every day. Their main purpose is to deliver important information quickly, briefly, and clearly.

However, in practice, announcements are not always written correctly. Sometimes there are spelling mistakes, sometimes grammatical or stylistic issues. As a result, even a simple announcement may become unclear or unreliable. In fact, announcement texts should be the simplest, clearest, and most accurate type of writing.

ASOSIY QISM

E'lon tilida uchraydigan xatolarni oddiy qilib aytganda, to'rtta asosiy guruhga bo'lish mumkin: grammatik xatolar, imlo xatolari, leksik xatolar va uslubiy kamchiliklar. Har biri o'ziga xos sabab va ko'rinishga ega.



Birinchi navbatda grammatik xatolar haqida to‘xtalsak, bu ko‘pincha gap tuzilishining noto‘g‘ri bo‘lishi bilan bog‘liq. E‘lon yozishda ba‘zi odamlar so‘zlarni tartibsiz joylashtiradi yoki qo‘shimchalarni noto‘g‘ri ishlatadi. Masalan, “Darslar boshlanadi soat 8da” deyish o‘rniga

“Darslar soat 8da boshlanadi” deyish to‘g‘ri hisoblanadi. Oddiy ko‘rinadigan bu farq aslida matnning tushunilishiga katta ta‘sir qiladi.

Ikkinchi tur — imlo xatolari. Bu eng ko‘p uchraydigan kamchiliklardan biridir. Ko‘pincha shoshilib yozish yoki e‘tiborsizlik sababli so‘zlar noto‘g‘ri yoziladi. Masalan, “qabul” o‘rniga “qabol”, “maktab” o‘rniga “makatb” kabi xatolar uchrashi mumkin. Bunday xatolar e‘lonning rasmiy ko‘rinishini buzadi va unga bo‘lgan ishonchni kamaytiradi.

Uchinchi guruh — leksik xatolar. Bu noto‘g‘ri so‘z tanlash bilan bog‘liq. Hozirgi vaqtda e‘lonlarda ruscha yoki inglizcha so‘zlar ham aralash ishlatiladi. Masalan, “registratsiya” so‘zi o‘rniga “ro‘yxatdan o‘tish”, “informatsiya” o‘rniga “ma‘lumot” so‘zini ishlatish ancha to‘g‘ri va tushunarli hisoblanadi. Tilning tozaligi aynan shunday kichik tanlovlardan boshlanadi.

To‘rtinchi tur esa uslubiy kamchiliklardir. Bu e‘lonning ortiqcha cho‘zilishi, keraksiz so‘zlar yoki haddan tashqari rasmiy va murakkab iboralar ishlatilishi bilan bog‘liq. Aslida e‘lon juda sodda bo‘lishi kerak. Lekin ba‘zan “Hurmatli o‘quvchilar, sizlarga shuni ma‘lum qilamizki...” kabi ortiqcha kirish so‘zlari matnni og‘irlashtiradi. O‘quvchi esa e‘lonni tez va oson tushunishi kerak.

Umuman olganda, e‘lonlardagi xatolarning asosiy sabablari — til qoidalarini yetarli bilmaslik, shoshilib yozish va norasmiy nutq ta‘siridir. Ayniqsa ijtimoiy tarmoqlardagi qisqartirilgan yozish uslubi ham e‘lon tiliga salbiy ta‘sir ko‘rsatmoqda.

MAIN PART



Errors in announcement language can generally be divided into four main types: grammatical errors, spelling errors, lexical errors, and stylistic problems. Each of them has its own causes and characteristics.

First, grammatical errors are usually related to incorrect sentence structure. In some announcements, words are placed in a wrong order or grammatical endings are used incorrectly. For example, instead of saying “Classes start at 8 o’clock,” some may write “Start classes at 8 o’clock,” which is incorrect in standard usage. Even such a small change can affect clarity.

Second, spelling errors are among the most common mistakes. They usually occur due to carelessness or haste. For example, “acceptance” may be written incorrectly as “acseptance,” or similar mistakes may appear in Uzbek texts as well. Such errors reduce the professionalism of the announcement and lower trust in it.

Third, lexical errors are related to the wrong choice of words. In many announcements, Russian or English borrowings are used unnecessarily. For instance, instead of using “registration,” it is better to use “sign up” or “enrollment,” and instead of “information,” the word “details” or “information” in the native language context is preferred. Using correct vocabulary helps maintain language purity and clarity.

Fourth, stylistic errors occur when the announcement becomes too long, complicated, or emotionally overloaded. An announcement should be short and direct, but sometimes phrases like “Dear students, we would like to inform you that...” make the text unnecessarily heavy. A good announcement should be simple and easy to understand at first reading.

Overall, the main reasons for these errors include insufficient knowledge of language rules, writing in a hurry, and the influence of informal speech. In particular,



the language style used on social media also affects the way announcements are written.

XULOSA

Xulosa qilib aytganda, e'lon tili oddiy ko'ringani bilan juda muhim kommunikativ vazifani bajaradi. Chunki u orqali berilgan axborot ko'plab odamga yetib boradi. Agar e'lon noto'g'ri yozilsa, ma'no buzilishi yoki tushunmovchilik yuzaga kelishi mumkin.

Shuning uchun e'lon yozishda grammatik qoidalarga amal qilish, imloni to'g'ri yozish, aniq va sodda so'zlarni tanlash juda muhimdir. Har bir e'lon qisqa, tushunarli va ortiqcha bezaklarsiz bo'lishi kerak.

To'g'ri yozilgan e'lon nafaqat axborotni aniq yetkazadi, balki til madaniyatini ham ko'rsatadi. Shu sababli e'lon yozish oddiy ish emas, balki e'tibor va mas'uliyat talab qiladigan jarayondir.

CONCLUSION

Announcement language plays an important communicative role in society. Errors in such texts can negatively affect clarity and understanding. Therefore, it is essential to follow grammatical rules, spelling norms, and stylistic principles when writing announcements.

A properly written announcement not only delivers information accurately but also reflects language culture. For this reason, writing announcements is not a simple task but a process that requires attention and responsibility.

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
