### WHAT IS ANALYTICAL THINKING?

According to Cottrell(2019), analytical thinkers actively question assumptions and examine relationships between ideas to create deeper understanding.

#### 1. Helps build strong and logical arguments.

Writers who use analytical thinking can connect evidence to claims more effectively. They avoid emotional reasoning and rely on logical structures to support their ideas. For example, instead of simply listing information from sources, analytical writers explain how and why the evidence supports their thesis.

#### 2. IMPROVES CLARITY AND COHERENCE

Analytical thinking enables writers to organize ideas clearly and logically. When students classify the information, compare viewpoints, and evaluate strengths and weaknesses, their writing becomes more coherent. As Bailey(2018)notes, analytical organization is essential for producing academic texts that are easy for readers to follow.

### 3.ENCOURAGES CRITICAL EVALUATION OF SOURCES.

Academic writing requires the use of credible sources. Analytical thinkers assess the reliability, relevance and limitations of the materials the use. This prevents plagiarism and promotes originality,as students learn to integrate sources with their own interpretation rather than copying information.

### 4.ENHANCES PROBLEM-SOLVING AND INDEPENDENT THINKING

Analytical writing tasks often involve identifying problems,exploring possible solutions, and making evidence-based recommendations. This process encourages independent thinking, allowing students to move beyond memorization toward deeper intellectual engagement(Paul&Elder,2014).

### HOW TO DEVELOP ANALYTICAL THINKING IN WRITING.

Students can improve their analytical writing through specific strategies:

- Asking questions such as WHY?,HOW? And What is the significance?
- COMPARING ideas from different authors or theories.
- Identifying cause and effect relationships in arguments.
- Evaluating evidence instead of simply describing it.
- Reflecting on assumptions and recognizing bias.

By consistently practicing these strategies,students gradually become more analytical confident in their academic writing.
