



## FORMATIVE AND SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT: ANALYSIS OF EFFECTIVENESS IN FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING

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**Abstract:** *This study analyzes the role and importance of formative and summative assessment in foreign language teaching, as well as their impact on educational effectiveness. Formative assessment is considered a tool that serves to continuously monitor students' learning process and gradually develop their knowledge and skills. This paper examines the relationship between these two types of assessment, their advantages and disadvantages, and the methods of their effective use in foreign language teaching. The results of the study show that the harmonious use of formative and summative assessment increases students' motivation in the language learning process, develops independent thinking and communicative competences. Also, this approach to assessment allows teachers to improve teaching strategies and strengthen the individual approach.*

**Annotatsiya:** *Ushbu tadqiqotda xorijiy tillarni o'qitishda formativ va summativ baholashning o'rni va ahamiyati hamda ularning ta'lim samaradorligiga ta'siri tahlil qilinadi. Formativ baholash o'quvchilarning o'quv jarayonini doimiy nazorat qilish, ularning bilim va ko'nikmalarini bosqichma-bosqich rivojlantirishga xizmat qiluvchi vosita sifatida qaraladi. Ushbu ishda ushbu ikki turdagi baholash o'rtasidagi bog'liqlik, ularning afzalliklari va kamchiliklari, chet tilini o'qitishda*



ulardan samarali foydalanish usullari ko'rib chiqiladi. Tadqiqot natijalari shuni ko'rsatadiki, formativ va summativ baholashdan uyg'un foydalanish o'quvchilarning til o'rganish jarayonida ishtiyoqini oshiradi, mustaqil fikrlash va kommunikativ kompetentsiyalarni rivojlantiradi. Shuningdek, baholashga bunday yondashuv o'qituvchilarga o'qitish strategiyasini takomillashtirish va individual yondashuvni kuchaytirish imkonini beradi.

**Аннотация:** В данном исследовании анализируется роль и значение формирующего и итогового оценивания в преподавании иностранных языков, а также их влияние на эффективность обучения. Формирующее оценивание рассматривается как инструмент, служащий для непрерывного мониторинга процесса обучения студентов и постепенного развития их знаний и навыков. В работе исследуется взаимосвязь между этими двумя типами оценивания, их преимущества и недостатки, а также методы их эффективного использования в преподавании иностранных языков. Результаты исследования показывают, что гармоничное использование формирующего и итогового оценивания повышает мотивацию студентов в процессе изучения языка, развивает самостоятельное мышление и коммуникативные компетенции. Кроме того, такой подход к оцениванию позволяет преподавателям совершенствовать стратегии обучения и укреплять индивидуальный подход.

## Introduction

In the current globalization process, learning and teaching foreign languages is becoming one of the priority areas of the education system. In particular, the role of language competencies in ensuring international cooperation, academic exchange



and competitiveness in the modern labor market is invaluable. Therefore, the issue of improving foreign language teaching methods and effectively assessing students' knowledge, skills and qualifications is of urgent importance. The assessment process is considered an important tool not only for determining the level of knowledge of students, but also for managing, motivating and developing their learning process [1].

Two main types of assessment are widely used in the education system - formative and summative assessment. Formative assessment is carried out regularly during the educational process, serves to improve learning by determining the level of students' mastery and providing immediate feedback. This approach increases the active participation of students and encourages them to take a responsible approach to their learning process [5]. Summative assessment, on the other hand, is conducted at the end of a specific learning phase and focuses on assessing the overall performance of students. This type of assessment is important for monitoring the quality of education, determining the effectiveness of educational programs, and making official decisions [3].

The issue of combining these types of assessment in the process of foreign language teaching has been widely covered in scientific research. For example, Hattie emphasizes in his research that effective feedback and continuous assessment significantly increase students' mastery indicators [4]. Brown also notes that the assessment process in foreign language teaching is closely related to the formation of communicative competence [7]. Therefore, assessment should cover not only the result, but also the learning process itself.

The purpose of this thesis is to analyze the effectiveness of formative and summative assessment in foreign language teaching, to reveal their interrelationships, and to identify effective methods for their application in practice. At the same time, this work also covers the issues of increasing students' activity in the language learning process and developing their communicative competences based on modern approaches to assessment.



In the process of teaching a foreign language, the assessment system is an important pedagogical tool for determining the knowledge, skills and competencies of students, as well as for managing and developing their learning process. In particular, the scientifically based and harmonious use of formative and summative assessment types significantly increases the effectiveness of education. This section will discuss in detail the content, importance, specific features and practical application of these types of assessment in foreign language teaching [8].

First of all, if we touch on the concept of formative assessment, it is an integral part of the educational process, is carried out continuously and serves to monitor the level of students' mastery. This type of assessment is more often interpreted as “assessment for learning”. Its main goal is to identify the strengths and weaknesses of students and determine the necessary pedagogical measures for their development. For example, in foreign language classes, students' language skills are regularly assessed through oral questions and answers, mini-tests, written exercises, and pair and group work. This approach allows students to recognize their mistakes, correct them, and gradually consolidate their knowledge.

Another important aspect of formative assessment is the presence of effective feedback. Clear and understandable feedback provided by the teacher motivates the student to work on himself. For example, when checking written work, it is important not only to point out errors, but also to give explanations on how to correct them. This develops reflective skills in students and directs them to independent learning. Also, methods such as self-assessment and peer assessment are effective tools of formative assessment [1]. These methods develop critical thinking in students and actively involve them in the learning process.

Summative assessment is carried out at the end of a certain stage of the educational process and is aimed at determining the overall results of students. It is considered an “assessment of learning”. This type of assessment is usually carried out in the form of midterm examinations, final exams, tests or project work. Summative assessment in foreign language teaching allows for a comprehensive assessment of students' listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills. For example,



international language exams (IELTS, TOEFL) are perfect examples of summative assessment, which determine the student's overall language level. At the same time, summative assessment also has some limitations. It is mainly result-oriented and does not allow for a deep analysis of the learning process itself. In some cases, students tend to study only for the sake of grades, which can reduce their motivation to learn. Therefore, modern pedagogical approaches emphasize the need to combine summative assessment with formative assessment. The integration of formative and summative assessment is one of the most effective approaches in foreign language teaching. In this case, through formative assessment, the learning process of students is constantly monitored and necessary adjustments are made, while summative assessment determines the final result. For example, during the semester, students are assessed through various tasks (formative), and at the end of the semester, their level of knowledge is determined through a common test or exam (summative). These two types of assessment complement each other and increase the quality of the educational process.

The effectiveness of assessment in foreign language teaching largely depends on the methods and technologies used. Interactive methods, digital platforms, and online assessment tools are widely used in modern education. For example, platforms such as Google Forms, Quizizz, and Kahoot allow for quick and effective formative assessment. This increases students' interest and actively involves them in the learning process [6].

In addition, assessment in lessons based on a communicative approach should also be appropriate for communicative tasks. That is, the assessment process takes into account students' ability to use language in real-life situations. Students' verbal competence is assessed through role-playing games, presentations, dialogues, and monologues. This develops not only their grammatical knowledge, but also practical language skills.

The effectiveness of assessment in foreign language teaching depends not only on its type, but also on its criteria (criteria) and transparency. Criterion-referenced assessment plays an important role in modern pedagogy. In this approach,



students' results are assessed based on specific criteria that are set in advance. For example, when assessing written work, grammar, vocabulary, content and logical structure are checked based on separate criteria. This increases the objectivity of the assessment and clearly shows students what needs to be improved. Diagnostic assessment is also important in foreign language teaching. This type of assessment is usually carried out at the beginning of the educational process and serves to determine the initial level of knowledge of students. Based on the results of the diagnostic assessment, the teacher adjusts the lesson plan and implements an individual approach. This is especially important in groups with students of different levels.

In addition, the concept of authentic assessment is widely used in modern education. In this approach, students' knowledge is assessed through tasks that are close to real-life situations. For example, tasks such as conducting an interview, writing an email, giving a presentation, or expressing an opinion on a specific topic are given. Such assessment is especially effective in developing students' communicative competence. The portfolio assessment method is also widely used in foreign language teaching. In this method, the work done by the student over a certain period of time is summarized - written assignments, projects, test results, and other materials. Through the portfolio, it is possible to monitor the dynamics of the student's development. This is useful not only for the teacher, but also for the student himself, who can see his progress.

Another important aspect is to take into account individual differences in assessment. Each student has their own learning pace, style and abilities. Therefore, a differential assessment approach should be used. For example, some students may perform well in written assignments, while others may be strong in oral speech. The teacher should take these aspects into account when assessing. Another modern direction of assessment in foreign language teaching is competency-based assessment. This approach assesses not only theoretical knowledge, but also the student's ability to use the language in real situations. For example, the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) system was developed



on this basis, in which students' language levels (A1, A2, B1, etc.) are determined based on specific skills. It is also important to take into account psychological factors in the assessment process. Some students cannot fully demonstrate their knowledge due to excitement during the exam. Therefore, using different forms of assessment (oral, written, practical, interactive) allows students to better demonstrate their capabilities. With the development of digital technologies, the assessment system is also changing significantly. Artificial intelligence-based platforms allow for quick and accurate analysis of student responses. For example, programs that automatically check written texts or applications that evaluate pronunciation are becoming effective aids in language learning. This saves the teacher's time and makes the assessment process more efficient.

## Conclusion

In conclusion, the assessment system in the process of teaching a foreign language is one of the most important factors ensuring the effectiveness of education. In particular, the scientifically based and harmonious use of formative and summative assessment types plays an important role in the development of students' knowledge, skills and competencies. While formative assessment continuously supports the learning process and allows students to understand and correct their mistakes, summative assessment serves to determine their overall level of mastery. The most effective results are achieved when these two types of assessment are used in an integrated manner, rather than separately. Thus, in order to achieve effective results in foreign language teaching, it is necessary to organize the assessment system in a comprehensive and balanced manner. The quality and efficiency of the educational process can be further improved by combining formative and summative assessment, using modern pedagogical approaches, and taking into account the needs and capabilities of students.

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
