

**MODERN METHODOLOGICAL METHODS IN TEACHING

The study concludes that combining different modern methods creates a more balanced and learner-centered environment, making foreign language learning more interactive, enjoyable, and effective overall.

Annotatsiya: Ushbu maqolada chet tilini o'qitishda qo'llaniladigan bir qancha zamonaviy metodik yondashuvlar, jumladan, kommunikativ yondashuv, vazifaga asoslangan o'qitish, aralash o'qitish va o'yinlashtirish (gamification) ko'rib chiqilgan. Tadqiqot ushbu metodlar o'quvchilarning motivatsiyasiga, darslarda faol ishtirokiga va amaliy til ko'nikmalarini rivojlantirishga qanday ta'sir qilishini tahlil qiladi. Natijalar shuni ko'rsatadiki, kommunikativ mashqlar o'quvchilarga so'zlashishda ishonch hosil qilishga yordam beradi, vazifaga asoslangan o'qitish esa tilni real hayotiy vaziyatlarda qo'llashni yaxshilaydi. Gamification increased motivation, yet it worked best when used in moderation. Too many game elements sometimes distracted students from the actual language goals. Still, when applied thoughtfully, it made lessons more dynamic and helped shy students participate more actively.

Overall, the discussion shows that modern methods can greatly improve the teaching and learning process, but they must be adapted to the students' level, classroom conditions, and the teacher's goals. A combination of different methods seems to give the best results, as it covers various learning styles and keeps the lessons more balanced and effective.
