

**PRACTICAL APPLICATION OF WEB-BASED RESOURCES IN THE
METHODOLOGICAL TRAINING OF FUTURE ENGLISH TEACHERS**

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Annotation: The article focuses on the practical application of web-based resources in the methodological training of future English teachers. Anotatsiya: Maqola kelajakdagi ingliz tili o'qituvchilarining metodik tayyorgarligida veb-asoslangan resurslarning amaliy qo'llanilishiga bag'ishlangan. Unda raqamli vositalar va onlayn platformalarni o'qituvchilar tayyorlash jarayoniga samarali integratsiya qilish orqali pedagogik ko'nikmalar va kasbiy kompetensiyani rivojlantirish masalalari ko'rib chiqiladi. They help teachers distribute materials, assign tasks, and assess students' progress. Academic language learning platforms provide structured and high-quality educational content. BBC Learning English offers grammar, vocabulary, pronunciation, and listening materials. British Council Learn English provides interactive lessons and practice tasks for different levels. Cambridge English online resources support academic English and exam preparation. Multimedia resources such as TED Talks, YouTube lectures, and podcasts provide authentic language exposure. These resources help learners improve listening skills and understand real-life communication. Digital reference tools like Cambridge Dictionary Online and Oxford Learner's Dictionary support vocabulary development and writing accuracy. Corpus tools provide real examples of language use in context. Communication tools such as Zoom and Microsoft Teams allow real-time interaction between teachers and students and support online learning environments.

Online platforms such as LinkedIn groups, TESOL communities, and educational forums allow teachers to share teaching materials and discuss methodological issues.
