

THE ROLE OF FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT IN IMPROVING ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNING

Аннотация

Annotatsiya

Formativ baholash zamonaviy ingliz tili ta'limining muhim tarkibiy qismiga aylanib, yakuniy natijalarni baholashdan ko'ra o'quvchilarning rivojlanishi va muntazam fikr-mulohaza olishiga e'tibor qaratadi. These practices encourage active participation, promote learner autonomy, and create opportunities for meaningful communication. Furthermore, they help teachers adapt instruction according to students' needs and progress.

Recent studies suggest that formative assessment significantly contributes to the development of communicative competence, motivation, and self-regulated learning among English language learners. Therefore, understanding its benefits and practical implementation has become increasingly important in contemporary language education.

Methodology

The participants consisted of sixty intermediate-level students studying English as a foreign language at a higher educational institution. The research was conducted over two academic semesters.

The study also emphasizes the importance of feedback quality. Effective feedback should be timely, specific, and constructive in order to support meaningful improvement. Teachers play a critical role in creating an environment where feedback is viewed as an opportunity for growth rather than criticism.

Furthermore, peer assessment and self-assessment contribute significantly to collaborative learning and learner autonomy. These practices encourage students to reflect critically on their performance, develop evaluation skills, and engage in meaningful dialogue with peers. Such experiences not only improve language proficiency but also foster lifelong learning skills.

Overall, the findings suggest that formative assessment enhances both cognitive and affective dimensions of language learning, creating a more engaging and supportive classroom environment.

Conclusion

In conclusion, formative assessment represents an effective and learner-centered approach to English language teaching.
